- Bob Morris-Discussion about 87 Mill Street and permits. The council discussed looking into raising our fees to cover increasing cost for planning & Zoning.

- Mr. Booth- Is fall fest a go? Mrs. Miller said No.
- Mr. Absher asked how long we had to use ARPA funds. The Solicitor said that we have until the end of this year (2024) to report what the funds will be used for.

- Clock: Mrs. Miller reported that she spoke to Jeff Jeffries from The Clock Shop in Shrewsbury. He thinks he can work on clock. He will get some measurements and information and get together a quote for council
- Terri reported on speaking to Jason at Holley Assoc. about creating a plan for road repairs. Their Cost is \$110-\$150 per hour. The initial cost would be approx. \$500-\$700 dollars then \$present it000 to generate a plan and present it to council. Mr. Booth made a motion to move forward with initial assessment and Mr. Zimmerman seconded the motion. **Motion carried 6-0**

NEW BUSINESS:

- Halloween: Trick or Treat will be October 31st 6-8 pm. Residents are to leave porch lights on if they want to participate.
- Received an email from a neighbor of the Antique shop E. Main Street about grass. Terri will send them a letter to owner of property
- REC Double doors need replaced. Mrs. Miller made a motion to get a quote on replacing them with and without digital locks Mr. Booth seconded the motion. **Motion carried 6-0.** Terri will get someone to look at them and price doors with digital locks.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT: Sewage Pumping Violations: Solicitor met with Terri before the council meeting, and we only have 2 property owners in the Borough who are in violation. We will second out second letters and see if they pump. If not after the first of the year we will decide on a course of action if they have not pumped.
