- Mrs. Morris reported that water pump heater is set at 45 degrees and nothing is running. Terri will contact Met-Ed about increase in bill and if need be call Dorn Electric to find out what the problem is.
- Mr. Booth- 1. When is Fall Fest? Mrs. Miller answered that 2 companies backed out so the date is not set yet. 2. Mr. Booth reported that the Rec and VFW and Fire Company calendars were now on the Boro website. Terri requested that the fire company calendar be taken down and Mr. Booth requested the Cathy Testerman asked the fire company for permission to publish the Calendar on the Borough's website.
