### OPEN DISCUSSION OF COUNCIL PRESIDENT AND COUNCIL MEMBERS:

- Mr. Booth: 1. suggested instead of a burn ordinance the Borough buy a “forest fire risk” sign and have the fire company man it. Mr. Absher commented that he doubted the fire company would take on that responsibility. 2. Mr. Booth would like the no parking sign in front of his house moved. He stated that ordinance 93-1 states that the sign should be 35 feet from the corner and the sign is currently 85 feet from the corner which impedes his parking. After conversation it was decided Mr. Booth could move the sign to 35 feet from the corner.
- Mrs. Miller reported that 2 new businesses have opened in the Borough-TNT Fat Bottoms Food Truck and Inflate Your Party Bounce Houses
- Mrs. Morris asked that something be done about the weeds in front of Dollar General. Terri is to send them a letter.

### OLD BUSINESS:

- Rec Council- Terri will meet with Nicole tomorrow to get all the paperwork and financials from her. Terri will meet with John Harris on VFW paperwork when he returns from vacation in 2 weeks.
- SYCEMS Donation- After much discussion a motion was made by Mrs. Miller to make a donation to SYCEMS in the amount of \$5000 it was seconded by Mr. Absher. **Motion carried 4-1**
- Pothole on South Market Street was repaired by President Compher.

### NEW BUSINESS:

- Complaints about parking on Park Drive. Terri will look for an Ordinance concerning it. If we need to do an Ordinance then a traffic study will need to be completed. We will revisit this issue at next meeting.
- 129 Morris Ave is once again not complying with grass mowing ordinance. Terri is to send a letter
- 5 Mill Street complaint about grass. New owner has taken care of the lawn and will be cleaning up the property.
- Complaints received about the Antique shops in the square and on Main Street. President Compher will pay them a visit and ask them to make it more presentable.
- Emergency Access road at SESD is being used as a public thoroughway. We will need to revisit this before the start of school. SESD was previously denied public use of that road by the Borough.

### SOLICITOR'S REPORT:

- **Burn Ban Ordinance:** Council decided to not adopt a burn ordinance and just follow York County's burn bans when issued.
- **CCIS Agreement and Fee Schedule:** Need to have changes made to contract. Terri will set up new fee schedule and send to Craig for review.
- **SESD Stormwater Management Plan:** Mrs. Miller suggested that Dave Lipinski do the final inspection for Use & Occupancy Permit. Terri Will contact him. Mrs. Miller made motion to approve SESD stormwater Management Plan it was seconded by Mr. Absher. **Motion Carried 5-0**
