AN ORDINANCE

Amending an ordinance relating to the peace and order in the Borough of Fawn Grove, York County, Pennsylvania. adopted by the Fawn Grove Borough Council on April 18th, 1956 and approved by the chief burgess on the 24th day of April 1956, so as to increase the penalty of the violation thereof.

The Borough of Fawn Grove hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. That section 2 of that certain ordinance relating to the peace and order in the Borough of Fawn Grove, York County, Pennsylvania, adopted on the 16th day of April 1956. the Fawn Grove Borough Council, and approved the chief burgess on the 24th day of April, 1956 and whose effective date was the 20th day of May 1956 shall be changed to read as follows:

Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance is subject to a fine not exceeding Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) together with cost of suit and in default of payment thereof, to imprisonment not exceeding seventy-two hours

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective on or after December 1st, 1956.

Section 3 All ordinances or parts or ordinances not in accord with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
