ORDINANCE NO. 2021-02

**AN ORDINANCE OF FAWN GROVE BOROUGH, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
CREATING THE POSITION OF INDEPENDENT AUDITOR**

WHEREAS, Section the Borough Code provides that Borough Council may create the position of independent auditor; and

WHEREAS, Fawn Grove Borough Council desires to create the office of independent auditor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of Fawn Grove Borough, York County, Pennsylvania, under authority of law, as follows:

SECTION 1. INDEPENDENT AUDITOR. From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, all of the accounts of the Borough for this year and all subsequent years, shall be audited by an independent Auditor appointed each year by the Borough Council.

SECTION 2. APPOINTMENT OF INDEPENDENT AUDITOR ABOLISHES ELECTED BOROUGH AUDITOR. The appointment of an Independent Auditor abolishes the position of the elected Borough Auditors. Elected Borough Auditors in office shall continue to hold their office during the term which elected. The Borough Auditors shall not audit, settle, or adjust the accounts audited by the Independent Auditor, but shall perform the other duties of their office.

SECTION 3. REQUIREMENTS. Such Auditor shall be a certified public accountant or firm of certified public accountants registered in Pennsylvania.

SECTION 4. APPOINTMENT. Such Independent -Auditor shall be appointed annually by Resolution of Borough Council to make an independent examination of all the accounts and accounting records of the Borough for the fiscal year then closing.

SECTION 5. COMPENSATION. The compensation to be paid such Auditor shall be fixed by Borough Council.

SECTION 6. REPEALER. All prior ordinances that are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective five days after the date of its enactment as provided by law.
