ORDINANCE NO. 2008-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FAWN GROVE  
BOROUGH NUISANCE ORDINANCE KNOWN AS  
ORDINANCE 2004-3

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of Fawn Grove Borough, York County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. The following provision shall be added to the said Nuisance Ordinance as new Section I-A, to read as follows:

Section I-A. Definitions.

1. Abandoned or Junked Vehicle. When applied to a vehicle means any vehicle that is not currently inspected, is not currently licensed, or is not capable of passing a Commonwealth of Pennsylvania inspection in accordance with the then existing regulations and provisions of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code or while the vehicle has not been moved for a period of 45 days. Any other vehicle shall be considered abandoned when they have been left in position on a property for a period of 30 days or longer.
2. Vehicle. Any automobile, motorcycle, motor bike, mini bike, bicycle, go-kart, recreational vehicle, truck or other wheeled means of conveyance, motorized or self propelled.
3. Trailer. A wheeled device used as a means of carrying, hauling or conveying any vehicle, person, animal, object or boat.

Section 2. Subparagraph H of Section 3 is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

- H. Any and all places of unenclosed storage of abandoned junked or wrecked vehicles as herein defined, trailer, boat or machinery, excluding farm machinery when used upon an operating farm, or the parts thereof, with the exception of any junkyard duly permitted under the Borough's Zoning Ordinance.

This provision, Section 3, is amended by the addition of the following subparagraph

- K. Use, possession, sale or distribution of Consumer or Display fireworks except by permit as issued by the Borough. Application for said permit

must be made at least thirty (30) days prior to the planned event and may only be conducted by not-for-profit, charitable, educational, civic or veterans organizations.

Section 4. Repealer.

Any prior ordinance or part thereof which is inconsistent with the provisions contained herein is hereby repealed.


Section 5. Effective Date.
