YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

•ORDINANCE NO. 94-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF FAWN GROVE REQUIRING THE NUMBERING OF HOUSES AND BUILDINGS IN THE BOROUGH; ESTABLISHING RESPONSIBILITY FOR NUMBERING BUILDINGS; DETERMINING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE NUMBERING SYSTEM AND THE HOUSE NUMBERS; AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Fawn Grove, York County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. Building Numbering System Adopted. The plan and system for the numbering of houses and buildings and tracts of land as submitted, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby approved and adopted.

Section 2. Responsibility for Numbering Buildings. Within ninety (90) days of the passage and approval of this Ordinance, it shall be the duty of each and every owner of each and every house, building, or other structure in the Borough to cause the same to be numbered in accordance with this Ordinance and the system and plans hereby adopted and approved.

Section 3. Requirements for Numbers. The numbers shall be placed in a conspicuous place on or over each front door or on either side of the entrance, the same numbers to be of paint, metal, or other durable material and at least five (5) inches in height, the color of the numbers to be in contrast with the immediate background, and shall be so placed as to be in full view from the opposite side of the street.

It shall be unlawful to cover any house number with any sign, drapery, or other obstruction intending to conceal such number and all old numbers shall be removed from any house, building, or other structure when a new number has been assigned and when so directed by the Codes Enforcement Officer.

The Codes Enforcement Officer is hereby authorized to require the numbering or renumbering of any house, building, or other structure in accordance with this Ordinance.

Section 4. Numbering System. Market Street shall be the dividing line between East and West, and Main Street (TR 851) shall be the dividing line between North and South. The initial point in numbering houses on streets extending North and South shall be at Main Street, and the initial point in numbering houses on streets running East and West shall be at Market Street. North of Main Street the numbers shall commence at 1 and extend Northward consecutively, and South of Main Street the numbers shall

commence at 1 and shall extend Southward consecutively. West of Market Street the numbers shall commence at 1 and shall extend Westward consecutively, and East of Market Street the numbers shall commence at 1 and shall extend Eastward consecutively in accordance with the attached plan . All even numbers shall be on the South and West sides of the street, and all odd numbers shall be on the North and East sides of the street The houses on short or intermediate streets shall be numbered uniformly with the main streets paralleling the short or intermediate streets, whether or not the short or intermediate streets begin at the initial point.

Section 5 . Penalties. Any person, firm, or corporation who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction of, be sentenced to pay -a fine of not more than Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) and in default of payment thereof, to imprisonment for a term not to exceed thirty (30) days.

Section 6. Repealer. ALI Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 7 Severability. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance for any reason is found to be unconstitutional illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted and had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section, or part thereof not been included herein.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance becomes effective on the 7th day of February, 1994.
