ORDINANCE NO. 2008- /

**AN ORDINANCE OF FAWN GROVE BOROUGH
PROVIDING FOR AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL
COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF
DELEGATING THE AUTHORITY TO COLLECT THE
TAXES OF THE BOROUGH TO THE TAX COLLECTOR OF
FAWN TOWNSHIP PURSUANT TO SECTION 5511.4b OF
THE LOCAL TAX COLLECTION LAW.**

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDANED by the Borough Council of Fawn Grove Borough, York County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough Council of Fawn Grove Borough, York County, Pennsylvania is authorized and directed to execute and deliver an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement attached hereto and entitled Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement for the Joint Collection of Taxes (the "Agreement"). The specific terms, conditions and provisions of the Agreement are made a part hereof.

Section 2. The terms and conditions of the Agreement are those as set forth in the attached Exhibit

Section 3. The term of the Agreement is for a period of approximately two (2) years, commencing January 7, 2008 and ending January 2, 2010. In addition, the Agreement may be extended for an additional period of two years, commencing January 3, 2010 and expiring January 1, 2012, provided that the Tax Collector of Fawn Township agrees to continue to collect the Borough taxes.

Section 4. The purposes and objectives of the Agreement are to provide the Borough with the ability to continue to collect its taxes in an efficient manner and to provide for consistent collection of taxes in light of the vacancies in the Office of Tax Collector in the Borough. Further, the primary purpose of the Agreement is to delegate to the Tax Collector of Fawn Township all necessary authority and power to act as the Tax Collector of Fawn Grove Borough.

Section 5. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and should any section, subsection, clause, sentence or part thereof shall be held or declared illegal, invalid and unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the decision shall not affect nor impair any of the remaining sections, subsections, clauses, sentences or parts thereof. It is hereby declared that the intent of Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, subsection, clause or sentence or part thereof had not been included herein.

Section 6. All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall become effective upon the later date of enactment by Fawn Grove Borough or Fawn Township.
