

ORDINANCE NO. 83 - _____

YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF FAWN GROVE, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE FAWN GROVE BOROUGH CURFEW ORDINANCE OF DECEMBER 7, 1977.

WHEREAS, Council of the Borough of Fawn Grove, York County, Pennsylvania, on November 7 1977, enacted an ordinance establishing a curfew; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Fawn Grove desires to amend the foregoing ordinance as hereinafter provided;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Borough of Fawn Grove, York County, Pennsylvania, enacts and ordains as follows:

1. Section 2 of said ordinance of November 7 , 1977 is hereby deleted and the following inserted in its place, as follows:

"Section 2 - Unlawful Conduct of Minors and Prohibited Acts by Proprietors and Managers of Certain Places of Business.

A. It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 18 to be or remain upon any street, alley, park, playground or other public place, building, place of amusement and entertainment, vacant lots or other unsupervised places in the Borough between 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. the following morning unless such person is accompanied by a parent or guardian, or other person having custody of such minor, or unless in the performance of a duty directed by such parent or guardian, or other person having custody, or unless such person is in lawful employment making it necessary to be in such place after 11:00 p.m.

B. It shall be unlawful for any individual, firm, association, partnership or corporation, operating, managing or conducting any privately owned place of business carried on for a profit or any place of amusement or entertainment to which the public is invited to knowingly permit a minor under the age of 18 to be on or remain upon the premises of said establishment in the Borough of Fawn Grove between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. of the following morning.

All other provisions of the ordinance remain the same.
