

## AN ORDINANCE

Regulating the speed of motor vehicles in and along the public highways and streets of the Borough of Fawn Grove, and the parking of vehicles in and along Market Street in the Borough of Fawn Grove and providing penalties for the violation of the same.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Borough of Fawn Grove and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, whether principal or agent, to . violate or fail to comply with the following regulations pertaining to traffic in and certain uses of the highway and streets of the Borough of Fawn Grove, or to be a party thereto under the penalties herein provided:

Section One. Definition: Parking is defined as follows: The standing of a vehicle, except police or fire department vehicle or ambulance, whether occupied or not, upon a highway otherwise than temporarily for the purpose and while actually engaged in loading or unloading, or an obedience to traffic regulations or traffic signals,

Vehicle is defined as any motor driven vehicle operated in and along the public highways and streets of the Borough of Fawn Grove.

Section Two. Parking of vehicles as defined in this Ordinance shall be prohibited at all times on the west side of both North Market Street and South Market Street from the Mill Road in and through the Borough square to a point opposite the south side of the Fawn Grove Methodist Church property.

Section Three. NO PARKING SIGNS shall be erected at appropriate intervals on the west side of North and South Market Street as soon after the passage of this Ordinance by the Borough Council as may be convenient .

Section Four. No person shall operate a motor vehicle on the public highways and streets of the Borough of Fawn Grove recklessly or at a rate of speed in excess of twenty-five miles per hour.

Section Five. the erection of signs at appropriate intervals giving notice of this speed limit is hereby authorized.

Section Six, Any person or persons, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, for the first offense, be Subject

to a fine or penalty of not less than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars nor more than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars, to be collected by summary conviction before the Burgess or any Justice of the Peace as like fines and penalties are now collected by law, and, in case of nonpayment of such fine, to undergo imprisonment in the County Jail for period not exceeding five(5) days; provided, however, that any person so convicted shall have the right of appeal as in other cases of summary conviction.

Section Seven. That all ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.
