### PROTECT YOUR DEED FROM FRAUD

The Borough has received a letter from Laura Shue, the York County Recorder of Deeds. She has been receiving a growing number of calls concerning deed and record safety.

As of October 1<sup>st</sup>, the Office of the Recorder of Deeds has implemented a "Records Notification Service" for all homeowners in York County.

The service is designed to provide security and assurance that no document is recorded without the homeowner's knowledge.
