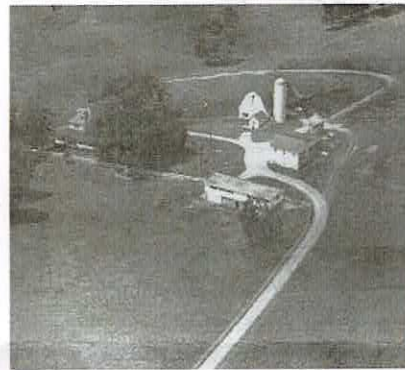
## BUSINESS SPOTLIGHT

*This edition featuring a Family Owned and Operated Business in Fawn Grove Borough since 1766*



Morris Family Farm is located at 358 North Market Street in Fawn Grove. The earliest deed transfers of the existing farm date back to 1766. Rolland and Jean Morris purchased the farm from the Sechrist family in April of 1961. From the date of purchase until the late 1990's, the

farm housed dairy heifers and dry cows and for a period of time cows were milked on the farm. The farm was operated by Robert and Beverly Morris from the 1970's until early 2000's. Over the years the farm has changed its look from additions and modifications to buildings and a silo being built for feed storage when the herd size increased. One of the biggest changes came in the 80's when a storm destroyed one of the original buildings by lifting off its roof and tossing it into another building. In the early 2000's dairy heifers left and were replaced with beef cows.



Today Todd and Liz Morris operate the farm which consists of small herd of beef cows and calves and feedlot made up from calves born on the farm and some purchased from family in Virginia. The farm ground and other local acres in the borough of Fawn Grove produces

all the feed needed for all the animals on the farm. The beef produced on the farm is all sold locally to customers in the community and surrounding area. One of the most recent changes to the farm was a stream restoration project to help clean up the waters of the creek that run through the pastures the cattle graze. One interesting fact discovered from the project was that the headwaters of the well-known Bald Eagle creek area located in borough in the farms pasture below the park.

## WEEDS & GRASS

In accordance with Ordinance No. 94, the growing of any grass, weeds, or vegetation not useful for edible or ornamental purposes to a height in excess of six (6) inches or which produces any noxious or offensive odors or pollens is considered a nuisance.



## BUILDING PERMITS

Please remember a permit is required for a shed, pool, deck, fence, resurfacing of a driveway and any addition to existing buildings or replacement of any of the previous items. Please contact Terri Marsteller, Borough Secretary, at 717-382-4153 for more information on the permit process.



## RECYCLE



Please remember that Tuesday is trash pickup and Friday is recycling. The two cannot be combined. Also, please make sure that the items to be picked up are out by 7:30 am. One large item per Tuesday will be accepted. Please place heavy objects in the bottom of the recycle cans to stabilize them, particularly on windy days. If you have any questions regarding the services, please contact Penn Waste at 717-767-4456.

*\*Please note Penn Waste reserves the right to pick up early on excessive heat days in the summer.*

## PUMP SEPTIC/CESSPOOL

All properties are required to pump their on-lot septic system at four (4) year intervals, or more often, if needed. Cesspools must be inspected no less than every four (4) years and pumped if needed. Holding tanks must be inspected yearly. A licensed septic system pumper is required to complete the York County Solid Waste Authority Manifest for all inspections and mail the report to the borough office in a timely manner.
